Extension of Request for expression of Interest (REOI) Medicinal Cannabis Operations in Aruba

On March 2nd, 2020 MTVS published a Request for Expression of Interest ("REOI") as part of a preliminary exploration from the MTVS and was intended to explore and determine the interest from parties in the market to be part of the medical cannabis industry of Aruba and to inventorize the type of interest that exists. The deadline for submission according to the REOI was April 6th, 2020.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic the MTVS had to prioritize attention, efforts and resources to participate in the activation and execution of a crisis plan for Aruba. By virtue of this extension the deadline for submissions is extended to July 31st, 2020. Accordingly section 19 of the REOI is hereby amended and re-instated as indicated below. All other sections of the REOI remain unchanged and in full force and in effect.

It is noted that submission need to comply with the requirements outlined in the REOI. The content and quality of the submission is a material aspect for evaluation. Submissions that only contain an expression of willingness or merely claiming ability to comply (in the future) with the requirements will not be considered as serious submissions and may be discarded from further consideration.
